

## 2016 EDGEFIELD COUNTY PROPERTY TAX RATE NOTICE

As Treasurer for Edgefield County, I will officially open the tax books for the collection of 2016 property taxes on Monday, **October 17, 2016**.

**Tax bills are in the name of the owner on record as of December 31, 2015**

If ownership has since changed and a tax bill is not received, it is the responsibility of the new owner to request one. **Failure to receive a tax bill because of an incorrect address or change in ownership will not result in the waiver of incurred penalties**. Omitted payments are the sole responsibility of the taxpayer.

**The tax bill should be presented when making the payment.**

If an escrow account is involved and the mortgage company requests the tax bill

for payment, the tax information will be supplied to the mortgage company and a copy mailed to the property owner. It is the property owner's responsibility to see that the tax bill is paid by the mortgage company and/or the property owner.

**All tax payments are due and payable without penalty by close of business on January 15, 2017.** Appropriate penalties as shown on the tax bill will be assessed and collected as a part of the total tax bill after January 15, 2017. No partial payments will be accepted. Tax payments bearing a United States postal stamped date of January 15, 2017, will be accepted without penalty.

*When the end of the tax period falls on Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the tax period is extended to the next business day. A legal holiday is any day the Courthouse or the offices of the United States Postal Service are closed.*
