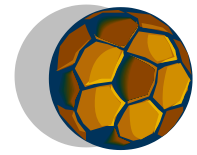

New 12-14 age division information

The Edgefield County Youth Soccer Association is excited to introduce a new age division to its soccer program. Beginning this season, players 12-14 (but not beyond eighth grade) will be eligible to play in a co-ed soccer division for this age group. The goal for this division is to prepare players with skills and experiences that will aid them if they go on to play high school soccer. This division will be more competitive and challenging for the players. In an effort to prepare them for the rules of high school soccer, this division will also have new rules and expectations for the players. Below are the major differences you can expect to see with this division. Parents will especially want to note that this is a contact sport, and as this division is a “step up” from the other divisions, you can expect the competition level to reflect such.

- Games and practices will be held at 7:30pm.
- Games and practices will be on Monday, Tuesday, and/or Thursday
- Teams may practice up to 3 times a week during pre-game season
- Teams can expect 1-2 games per week and 1 practice per week after games begin
- Players will only be guaranteed 30 minutes of play time each game.
- Games will be played in 30 minute HALVES not quarters.
- No overtime except in the case of tournament play
- Certified referees will be provided for this division
- Slide tackles will be taught and allowed
- “Kick backs” to goalies will be taught and allowed
- Yellow/Red cards will be used and their penalties enforced

General information for 4-11 age divisions

- Games and practices will be held at 6:00 pm.
- Games and practices will be on Monday, Tuesday, and/or Thursday
- Teams may practice up to 2 times a week during pre-game season
- Teams can expect 1 game and 1 practice or 2 games per week after games begin
- Coaches will try to play all players 3/4 of each game
- These age groups will focus on skill development and understanding the game

Balls, Shin Guards and Uniforms

- All players are responsible for buying black soccer shorts. Registration includes Jersey and socks.
- All players **MUST** have shin guards at practice and games.
- All players should bring a ball to every practice.
- Balls and shin guards will be for sale at registration: Shin guards =\$5 Balls = \$10
